This wise investment makes it possible for members to enjoy the best facility in the area.

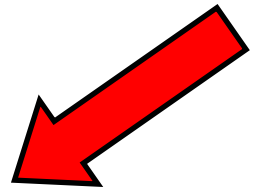
Our 2021 plans for dues and member volunteer assistance includes:

- These matches will be “Hit Factor” matches; no upload to USPSA
- Match registration and payment (\$7.00) on Practiscore
- USPSA classifier matches will be separate and announced
- All USPSA rules will be used for match procedures and safety
- .22 pistols or .22 rifles will be allowed.
- There will be 3 low round count stages at the match director’s discretion set up on TR, East and West Bays
- First match is Thursday, April 15 at 5:30 p.m. SHARP
- Last test run match is May 6, after which BOD will reevaluate

Range availability as a result of this change as follows:

- ⇒ Long Range closes at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesdays for set up for trap shooting
- ⇒ Long Range closes at 4:30 p.m. on Thursdays to allow set up and parking for the set up crew out back for the Thursday match
- ⇒ Eagles Range will be open on Tuesday nights

WINTER IMPROVEMENTS!

RANGE RULES

Range Security. Access is limited to members and their guests.

SECURITY CAMERAS have been installed to monitor the EAST and WEST parking lots, the front entrance, foyer and clubhouse. No cameras on the ranges.

Your FOB records your IN AND OUT. Close the gate each time you pass. Do not allow anyone else to enter without using their own FOB. There is a fee for lost FOBs.

Your FOB will open the front door to give members in good standing access to the MEDICAL EQUIPMENT located in the clubhouse foyer and the bathroom. FOB in on the FOB pad beside the door. Be sure to FOB out and close the door securely—check it! FOB keeps an electronic record of use

Please **SIGN IN** every guest in the log located in the box on the long range. Two (2) guests per member at a time, and no more than 3 times. Get them to join.

Wear your ID or have it visible to identify yourself as a member. Get to know who is using the facility.

Anyone deliberately destroying or damaging anything on the range, shoot houses, clubhouse or grounds, including wildlife, will be subject to immediate removal and will face the consequences of such actions in accordance with our ORGC Bylaws and Constitution.

Use of equipment provided in Eagles Range is a privilege of **membership**. It is expected that **all people who use the range will leave the range in good condition for the next user.**

Put all equipment away.

Remove your targets from the stand and discard.

Pick up your brass.

Put all tools away.

Put your trash in the trash can.



Do you remember hearing your Mother yell this familiar phrase? “CLOSE THE DOOR!! WERE YOU BROUGHT UP IN A BARN?” Oops. You’d run back and dutifully close the door never thinking that phrase would replay in your head. 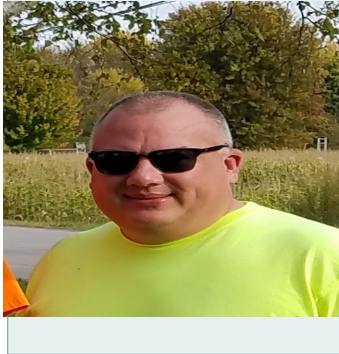


